

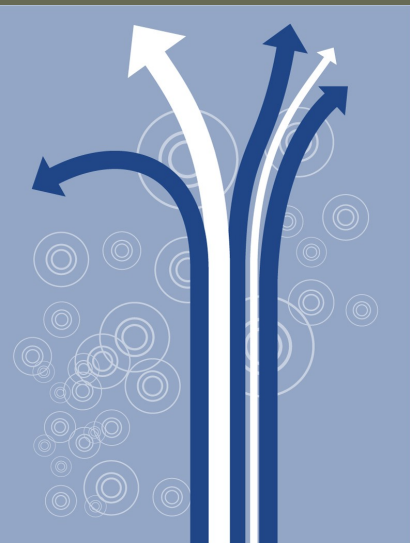

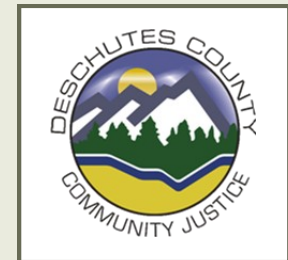

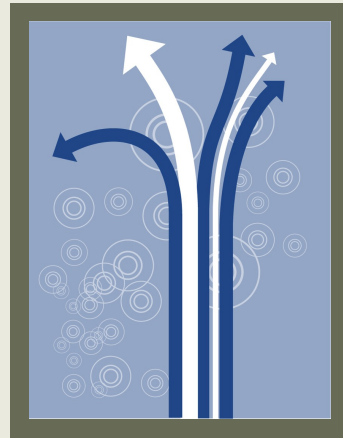


Offers 30-Day Extended Detention Services

- ◇ Participants receive individualized and structured learning plans associated with their identified risk factors.
- ◇ A staff is assigned to each participant. This staff is responsible to develop, implement and monitor plan progress, and provide 1:1 attention necessary for participant success.
- ◇ All youth participate in regular detention activities and programming.

CHOICES

¹Pursuant to ORS 419C.453, a youth may be held in detention up to 30 days, in addition to time already spent in a facility.

Referral Eligibility

Youth admission is based on the referral appropriateness, and is determined by Deschutes County. Eligibility includes, but is not limited to, the following circumstances:

- ◇ Youth is under the jurisdiction of the Court.
- ◇ Youth score medium to high on JCP / RNA risk assessments.
