RESOLUTION NO. 2015-086

WHEREAS, ORS 279A and the Sunriver Service District Contracting Rules generally require that contracts for public improvements be let to the lowest bidder; and

WHEREAS, the Sunriver Service District – through its Contracting Rules – has adopted the Model Rules of Public Contract Procedures, including applicable provisions of OAR 137; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the Sunriver Service District is designated as the District's Local Public Contract Review Board; and

WHEREAS, OAR 137-047-0275 authorizes the Local Public Contract Review Board to award a contract for goods or services without competition when it determines in writing that the goods or services, or class of goods or services, are available from only one source; and

WHEREAS, based on the findings in Exhibit A, attached and incorporated by reference, the Local Public Contract Review Board finds that the goods/services for the District's Lifeline Ambulance Remount is available only from Lifeline Emergency Vehicles, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to OAR 137-047-0275, public notice of intent to award sole source contract was published in the Bulletin Newspaper on 6/4/15 through 6/10/15 (Affidavit of Publication attached as Exhibit B) and no protests have been received; and

WHEREAS, because only one source is available to provide the necessary goods/services, the Governing Body intends to award the contract; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE SUNRIVER SERVICE DISTRICT acting in its capacity as the Local Public Contract Review Board, as follows:

AGENDA ITEM:

Award of contract for goods and services without competition, as a sole-source procurement, pursuant to ORS 279B.075.

FINDINGS IN SUPPORT OF PROPOSED ACTION:

1. The Sunriver Service District's Fire Department ("Department") requires upgrade of an existing ambulance vehicle for efficient use of the existing ambulance vehicle.
2. The Department has compared purchase of a new ambulance vehicle to replacement of the existing ambulance module only, and has determined that the approximately \$70,000 savings warrants replacing the existing ambulance module rather than the entire vehicle, as an efficient utilization of existing goods.
3. The Department purchased the existing ambulance vehicle from Lifeline Emergency Vehicles, Inc. ("Vendor").
4. The existing ambulance vehicle is covered by a lifetime warranty with Vendor.
5. The Department has determined that continuation of the existing warranty is a significant benefit.
6. The existing ambulance vehicle warranty will only continue if the Department procures the ambulance module replacement service and equipment from Vendor.
7. The Department has consulted with other departments and determined that, in their experience, Vendor's work and equipment provides good quality, price, and readiness to perform said ambulance module replacement.
8. The Department shall make best efforts to negotiate with Vendor to obtain contract terms advantageous to Department, as reasonably practical.

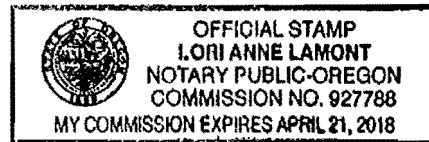
