ORDINANCE NO. 2015-008

WHEREAS, Order No. 2003-003 previously adopted public contracting rules for the Sunriver Service District and designated the Governing Body of the Sunriver Service District as the District's Local Contract Review Board; and

WHEREAS, the Managing Board of the Sunriver Service District has demonstrated that it has the necessary resources to serve as the Local Contract Review Board; and

WHEREAS, ORS 279A.060 provides that the Governing Body may by charter, ordinance or other local legislation authorize the Managing Board to serve as the Local Contract Review Board, now therefore,

THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE SUNRIVER SERVICE DISTRICT ORDAINS as follows:

Section 1. Pursuant to ORS 279A.060, the Managing Board of the Sunriver Service District is authorized to serve as the Local Contract Review Board of the Sunriver Service District.

Section 2. EMERGENCY. This Ordinance being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this Ordinance takes effect on its passage.
