This letter is provided in support of conducting the activities for Phase 2 and 3 of the Frontier Observatory for Research in Geothermal Energy (FORGE) on the unitized geothermal lease areas owned by Davenport Newberry Holdings, LLC (DNH), and located on the Newberry Volcano in Central Oregon. The unique characteristics present at Newberry make this an excellent choice for the FORGE, which include a geothermal gradient exceeding 85° C/km, measured data at depth, multiple existing wells, unitized lease ownership, road access, and water supply.
