Final Ballot Title The following is the final ballot title of the measure to be submitted to the district's voters. The ballot title notice has been published and the ballot title challenge process has been completed.

Five Year Local Option Levy for Emergency Services Operations.

Shall District Levy Taxes of \$0.89 per \$1,000 of assessed value for five years beginning 2019-20 for emergency services operations?

Crooked River Ranch Rural Fire Protection District provides fire, rescue, and emergency medical services for the Crooked River Ranch community. With this measure, the District's elected Board of Directors is asking voters to replace the current local option levy of \$0.69 per \$1,000 of assessed value. The new local option levy would increase the existing levy by \$0.20, making this new local option levy \$0.89 per \$1,000 of assessed value. The Board of Directors approved this request to address District needs, including:

- 1) Maintaining current staffing levels to continue to meet the needs of increasing call volume.
- 2) Meeting the District's minimum projected equipment replacement plan.
- 3) Maintaining and performing needed upgrades to the District's current fire station facility.

The levy would raise approximately \$286,437 in 2019-2020, \$295,030 in 2020-2021, \$303,881 in 2021-2022, \$312,997 in 2022-2023, \$322,387 in 2023-2024, for a total of \$1,520,731.

This measure may cause property taxes to increase more than three percent.

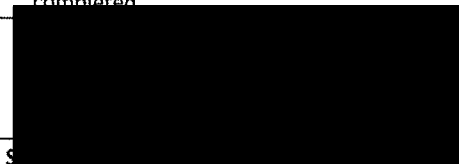
