REDMOND SCHOOL BOND TO INCREASE SAFETY, REPLACE SCHOOL, UPDATE CLASSROOMS

Question 20 words which plainly phrases the chief purpose of the measure.

Shall District increase student safety, replace elementary school, repair, improve other schools; issue \$70,000,000 general obligation bonds with citizen oversight? If the Bonds are approved, they will be payable from taxes on property or property ownership that are not subject to the limits of sections 11 and 11b, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Summary 175 words which concisely and impartially summarizes the measure and its major effect.

Passage of measure would finance capital costs related to certain construction, improvement and safety projects, including, but not limited to, the following:

- Replacement School: Construct, equip and furnish a new school to replace outdated M. A. Lynch Elementary;
- District-wide capital repairs and improvements to classrooms and school facilities for:
 - Student Safety and Security: Safety and security improvements such as secure entrances and new security camera systems;
 - Maintenance and Preservation to Extend the Life of Existing Buildings: Projects such as replacing roofs, plumbing and flooring and updating electrical, heating, ventilation and cooling systems;
 - Energy Efficiency Improvements: Projects to reduce maintenance and operating costs such as installing modern lighting and windows; and
 - Classroom Modernization: Improvements to aging school facilities to upgrade technology infrastructure and update learning spaces.
- Site improvements, demolition, furnishings and equipment and bond issuance costs.

Bonds would mature over a period not to exceed 21 years from the date of issuance, and the incremental increase over the 2017-2018 property tax rate is estimated to be \$0.54 per \$1,000 assessed value.
