Shall La Pine impose a three percent tax on the sale of marijuana by a licensed marijuana retailer? <span style="float: right;">17</span>

<p>State law provides that a city council may adopt an ordinance to be referred to the voters of the city imposing up to a three percent tax or fee on the sale of certain marijuana items by a licensed marijuana retailer. The La Pine City Council referred this measure to the voters as provided under state law. <span style="float: right;">56</span></p> <p>Approval of this measure will impose a three percent tax on the sale of marijuana items by marijuana retailers in the city. The tax will be collected at the point of sale and remitted by the marijuana seller. <span style="float: right;">38</span></p> <p>Under state law, a city that adopts an ordinance prohibiting the establishment and/or operation of a recreational marijuana retailer may not impose a tax or fee on the production, processing, and/or sale of marijuana or any product into which marijuana has been incorporated. This measure will become operative only if the measure proposing to prohibit (ban) the establishment and operation of recreational marijuana retailers is not passed (approved) by voters. <span style="float: right;">70 164</span></p>
