Dear Steve:

Pursuant to ORS 250.175(3), and in compliance with ORS 250.035(1), I prepared the following ballot title for the nonpartisan Deschutes County Commissioner county ballot measure.

CAPTION

Expand County Commission from three to five members.

QUESTION

Should Deschutes County Commission be expanded to include five members?

SUMMARY

Deschutes County's elected governing body, the Deschutes County Board of Commissioners, is currently composed of three elected members.

This ballot measure, if approved by electors, would expand the Board of Commissioners to include five elected members.

In addition, if approved, this ballot measure would set a schedule for the election of Commissioners to coincide with Presidential election cycles. Currently, one of three members is elected in Presidential election years. The two new positions added to the Commission would be filled by election at the next even-year election (2026) for initial terms of two years. In 2028, three Commission positions would appear on the ballot under the terms of this measure and those elected would serve four year terms of office thereafter. The two new positions may not be filled by appointment prior to January 6, 2027.

The provisions of this ballot measure may be amended only by majority vote of the electors of Deschutes County.

Notice of Receipt of Ballot Title and One Subject Determination

Notice is hereby given that the following Ballot Title for a proposed initiative petition has been filed with the Deschutes County Clerk on November 16, 2023. The County Clerk has determined that the proposed initiative meets requirements of Oregon Constitution, Article IV, Section 1, requiring that a measure shall embrace one subject only and the proposed text is legislative in nature.

CAPTION

Expand County Commission from three to five members.

QUESTION

Should Deschutes County Commission be expanded to include five members?

SUMMARY

Deschutes County's elected governing body, the Deschutes County Board of Commissioners, is currently composed of three elected members.

This ballot measure, if approved by electors, would expand the Board of Commissioners to include five elected members.

In addition, if approved, this ballot measure would set a schedule for the election of Commissioners to coincide with Presidential election cycles. Currently, one of three members is elected in Presidential election years. Per ORS 250.195 any elector dissatisfied with this ballot title, may file a petition for review of this ballot title in the Deschutes County Circuit Court no later than 5:00 p.m., November 27, 2023 (the seventh business day after the title was filed). The petitioner shall also notify the Deschutes County Clerk in writing no later than 5 pm on the next business day following the day the petition is filed.
