emergency medical services. The measure would provide for a local option operating levy at a rate of \$.76 cents per \$1,000 of assessed value for five years, beginning July 1, 2024. The prior levy of \$.20/\$1,000 of assessed value expires June 30, 2024, and on expiration would be replaced by this levy. Revenue from the levy would be used to provide sufficient staffing with the goal of assuring adequate response times. The funding could also support additional training and equipment necessary to maintain services. The rate of \$.76 cents per \$1,000 of assessed real property value is projected to raise approximately \$17,333,000 over five years. The estimated tax cost for this measure is an ESTIMATE ONLY based on the best information available from the county assessor at the time of the estimate and may reflect the impact of early payment discounts, compression and the collection rate.
