 - o Replace roofs, plumbing, flooring
 - Update electrical, heating, ventilation/cooling systems
 - o Install energy efficient lighting and windows
 - Install drought tolerant landscaping
- Critical Repairs, CTE Expansion at Redmond High School:
 - Replace 50-year-old heating system pipes at risk of failure within 5 years
 - o Expand and remodel spaces for vocational training and extracurriculars
- Expand Tumalo Community School to return to K-8 school
- Demolition, furnishings, equipment; bond issuance costs
