What?

Chart-FFT helps kids and parents find ways to reduce conflict, trouble and stress.

Chart-FFT is a new way to help families with kids ages 11-17 who are getting into trouble at home or school, or are involved with drugs.

- Counselors help find and build on **your** family's strengths.
- Counselors meet with the whole family once per week, for about 3 months.
- Free of charge.



Why?

Raising a Family is Hard Work

Families today have a lot of stress. Kids are faced with hard decisions about friends, drugs and alcohol. Parents are working hard to put food on the table. Every family can be the best family for its members, with a little help.

If you **are** or **have** kids between ages 11 and 17, and are experiencing:

- Conflict in the family or with peers
