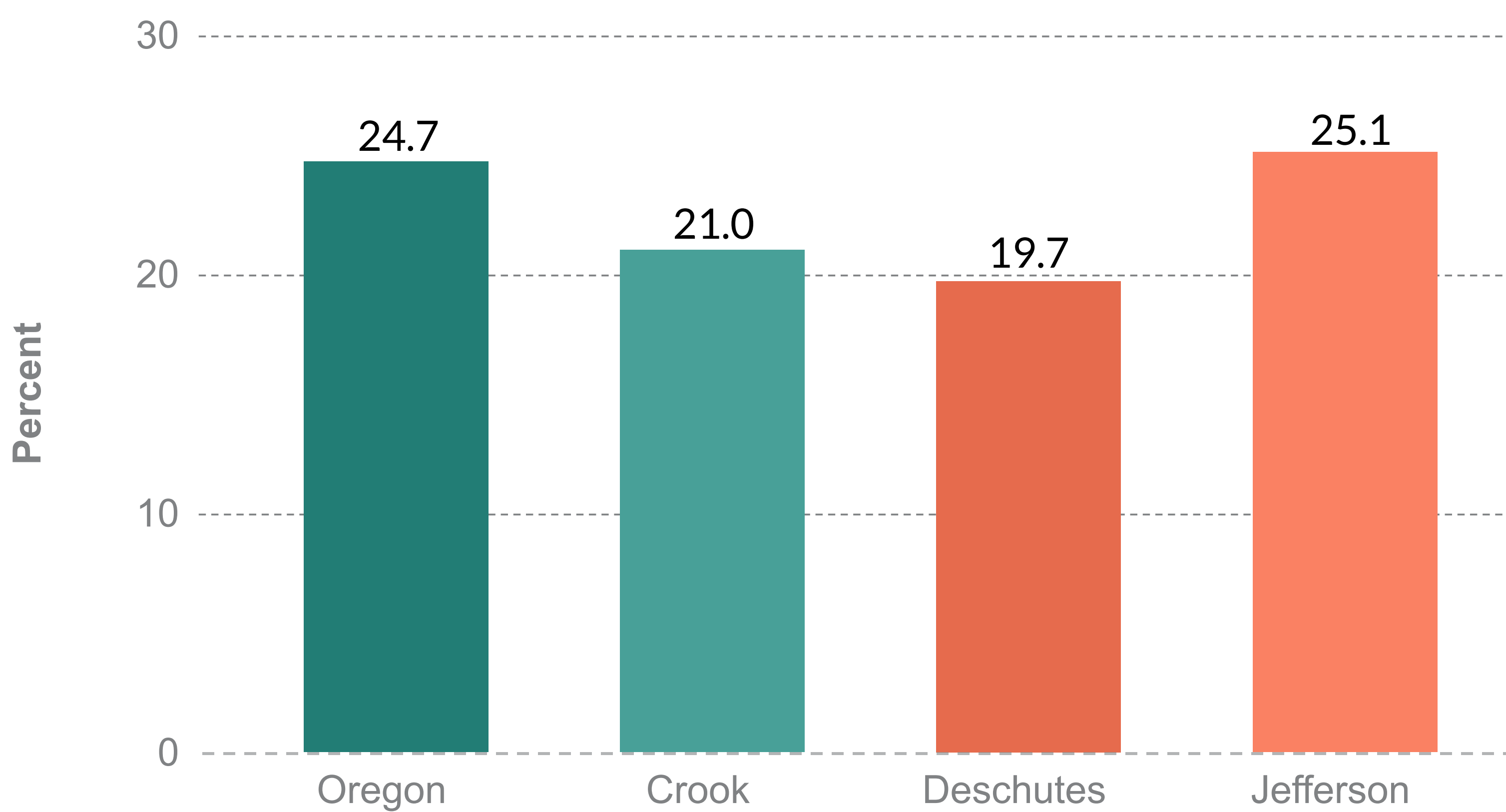

The percent of 11th graders who reported fair or poor emotional/mental health increased in all three Central Oregon counties.

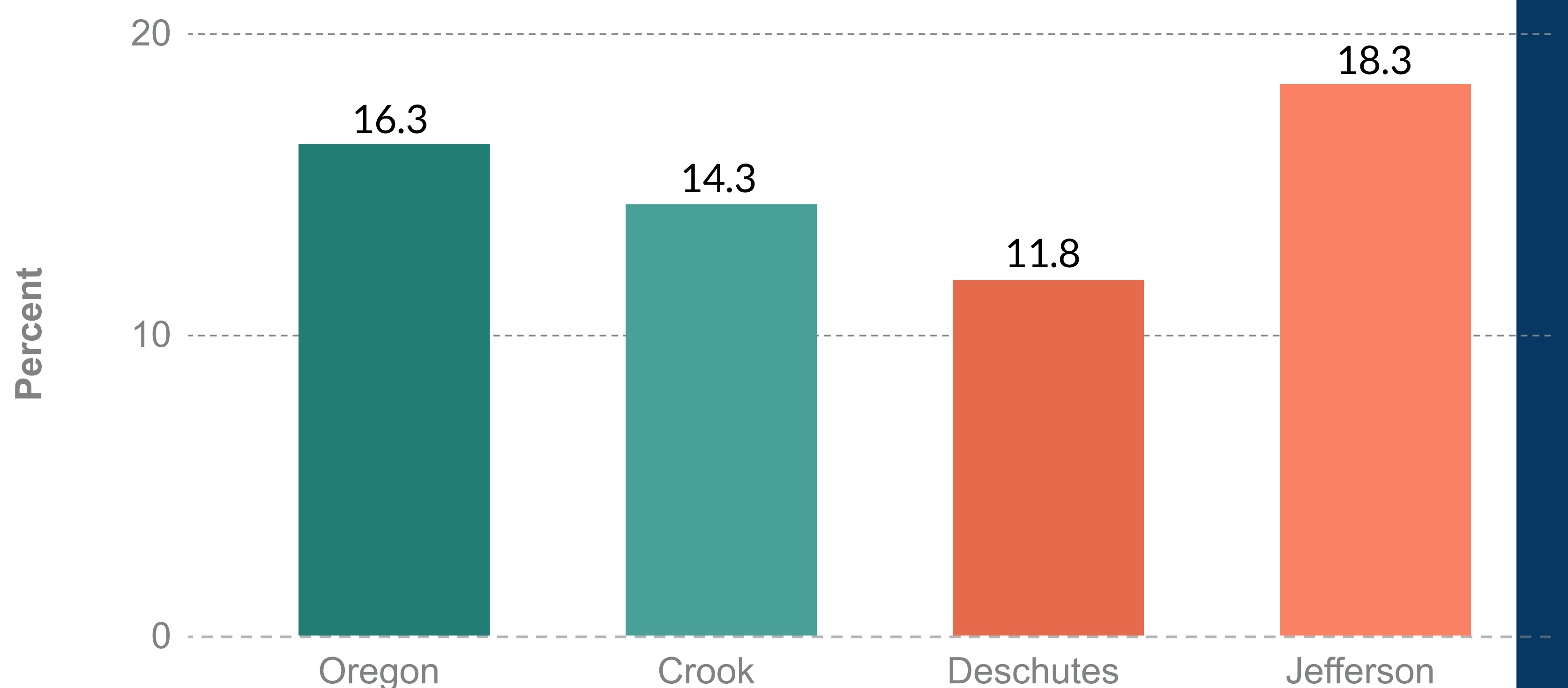

Youth Suicidal Thoughts

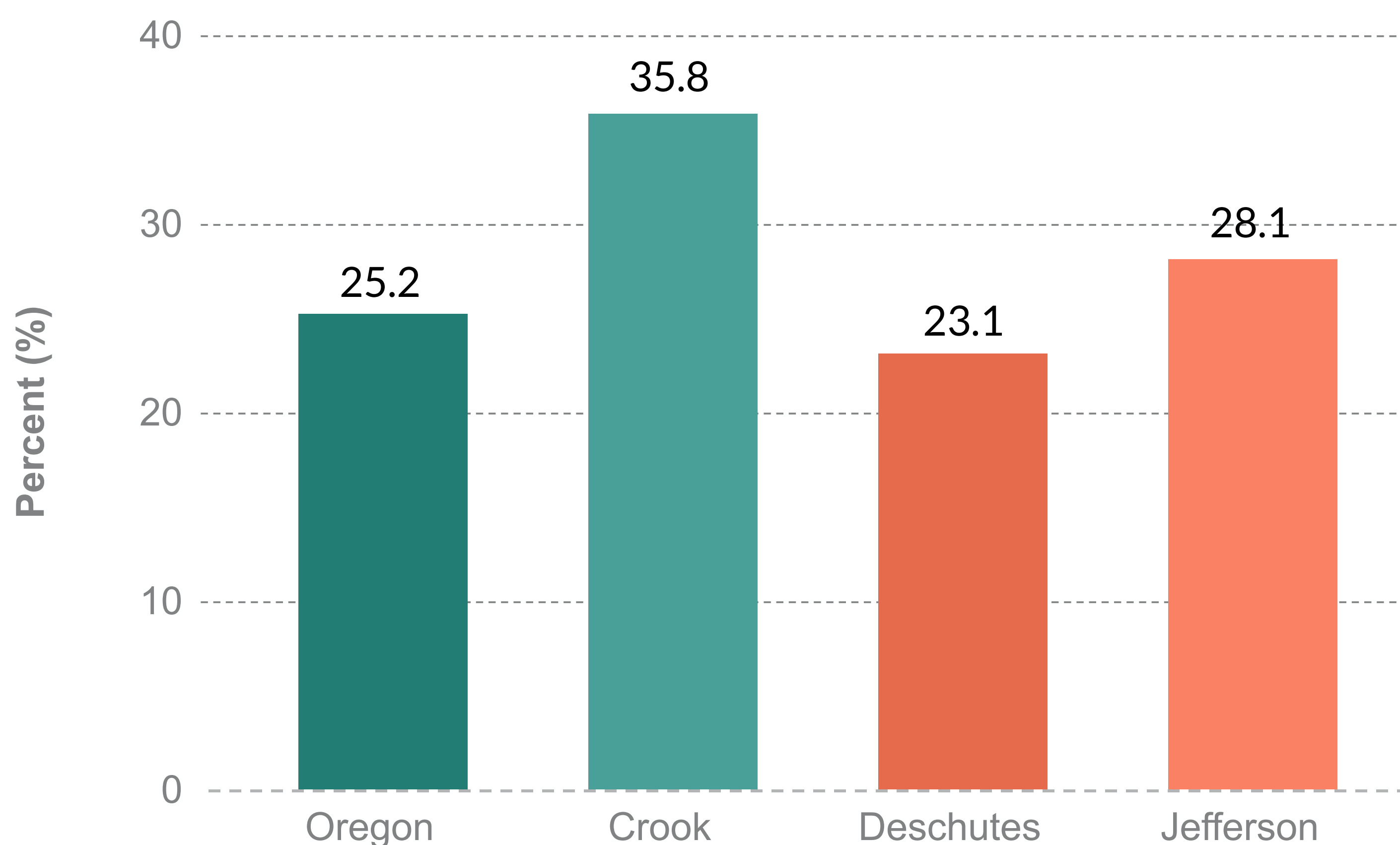
Percent of 11th graders who seriously considered attempting suicide over the past year

The percent of 11th graders who seriously considered attempting suicide decreased in Deschutes County, but increased in Crook and Jefferson Counties.

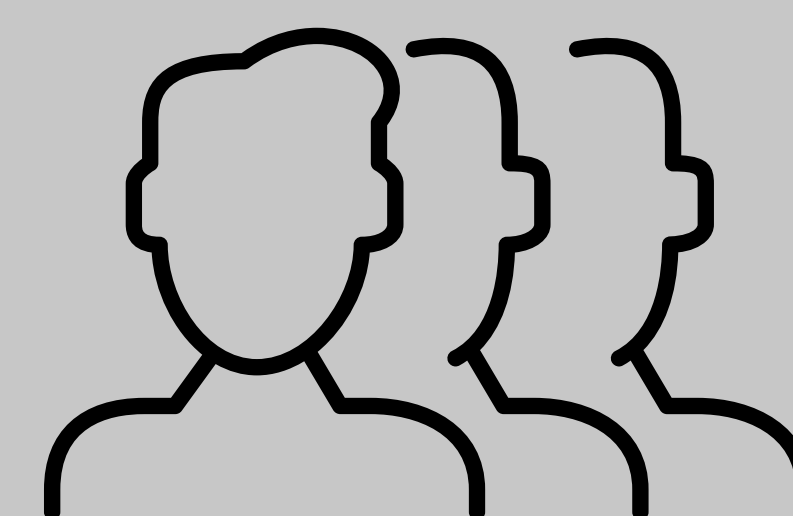

The percent of adults with depression increased in all three Central Oregon Counties.

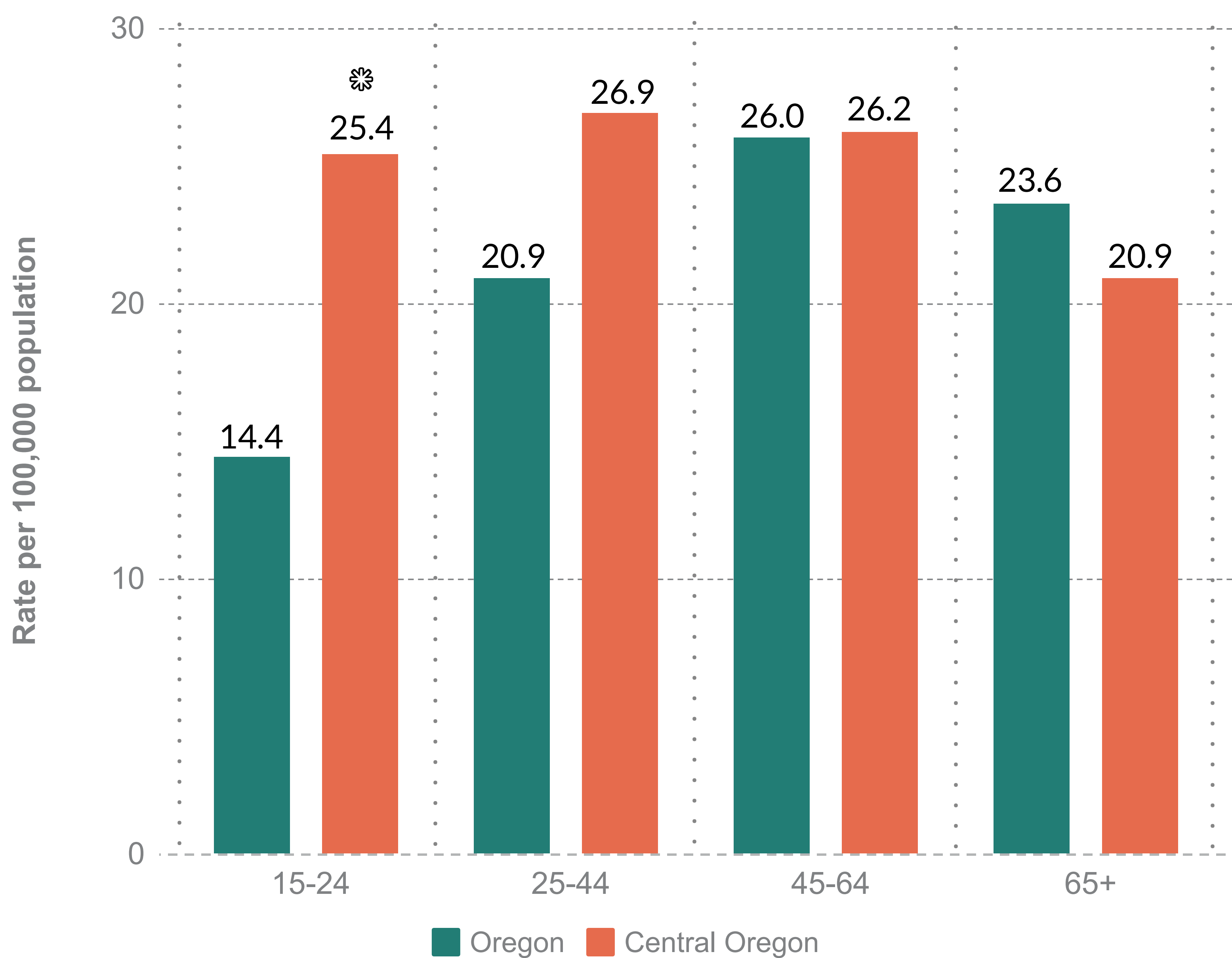
