

COVID-19 Case Counts by Week


Deschutes County Known COVID-19 Cases by Week

When to get tested?

- Before and after travel*
- If you have symptoms
- 6 to 9 days after you were exposed to someone who tests positive




Testing for travel

- Know the requirements most locations require PCR test results within 72 hours
- Visit <u>www.deschutes.org/covidtesting</u>
- Find a location on the OHA testing locator that meets your needs
- Call ahead to confirm test type and turnaround time
- Get tested and travel safely!




COVID-19 Daily Hospitalization Counts






Hospitalized COVID19 Patients, St. Charles System by Vaccine Status

Community Spread is Substantial


Community spread in Deschutes County is currently Substantial.

189.3 cases per 100,000 residents


6.8% test positivity rate

SHOULD I BE CONCERNED ABOUT THE DELTA VARIANT?

New data show Delta is different than past versions of the virus: it is much more contagious.

 Vaccinated people can get breakthrough infections of Delta variant and may be contagious.

•Vaccinated individuals represent a very small amount of total transmission.

With the Delta variant, vaccination is more urgent than ever.














COVID-19 Vaccinations in Deschutes County






COVID-19 Vaccinations by Age Group
