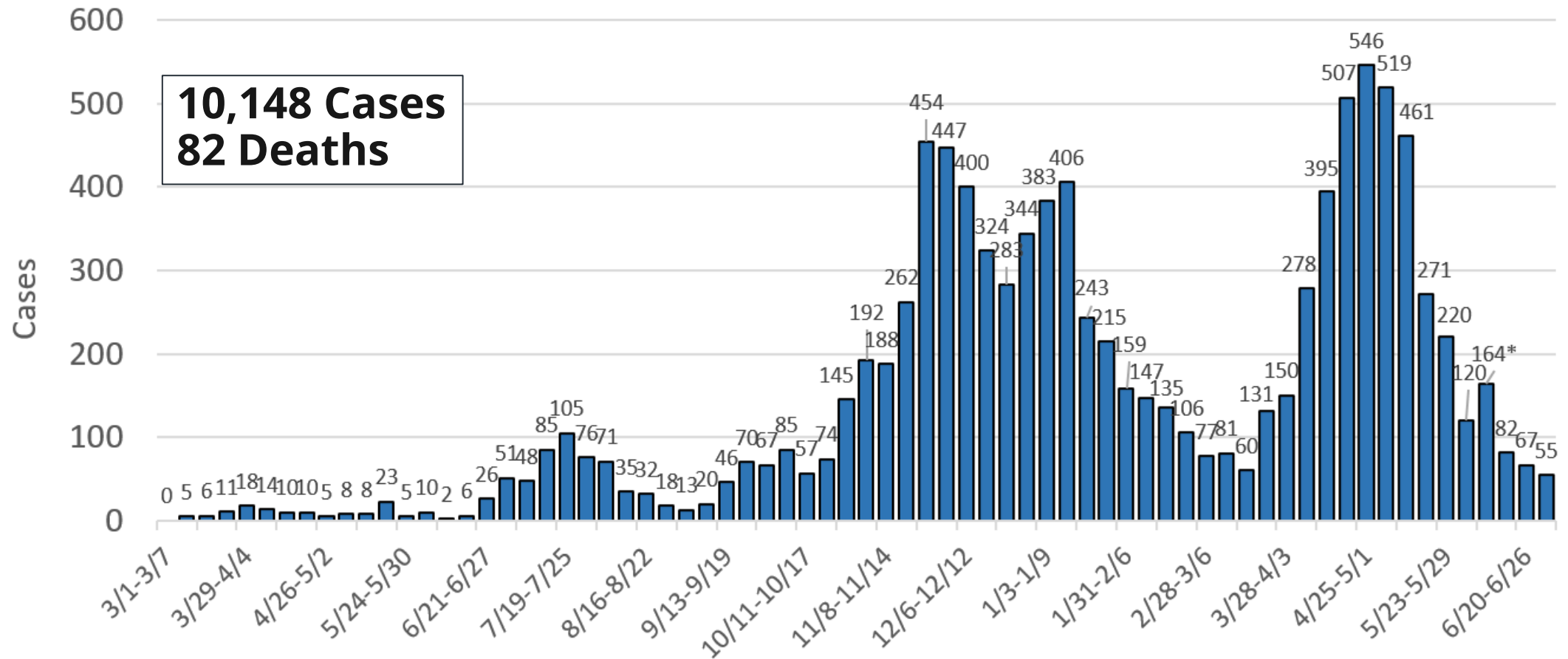

COVID-19 Case Counts by Week

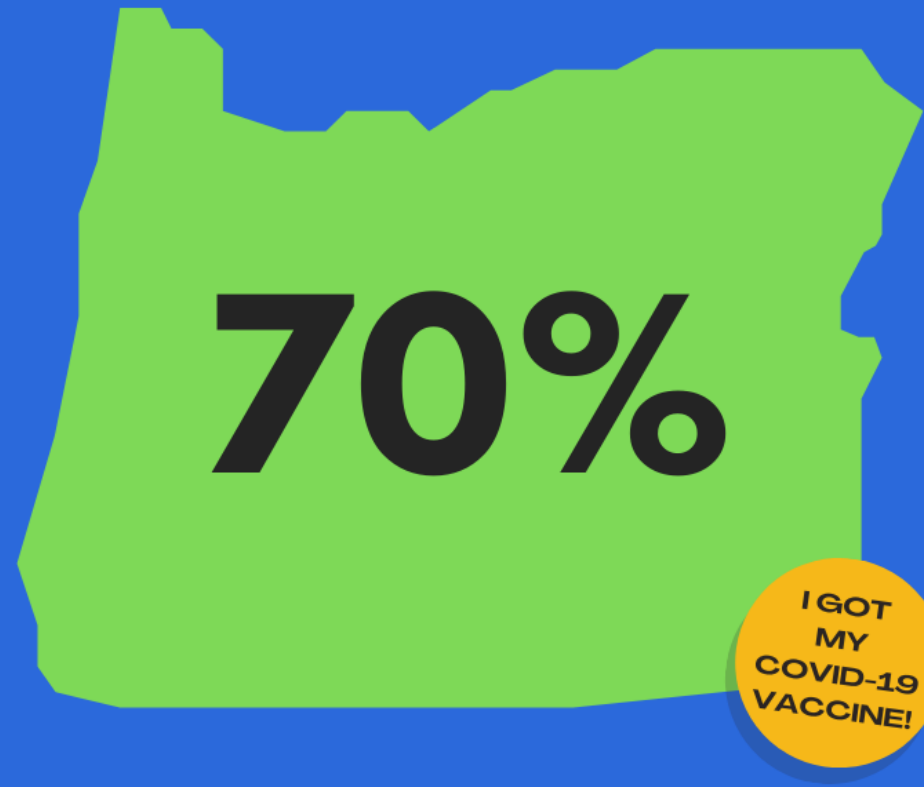

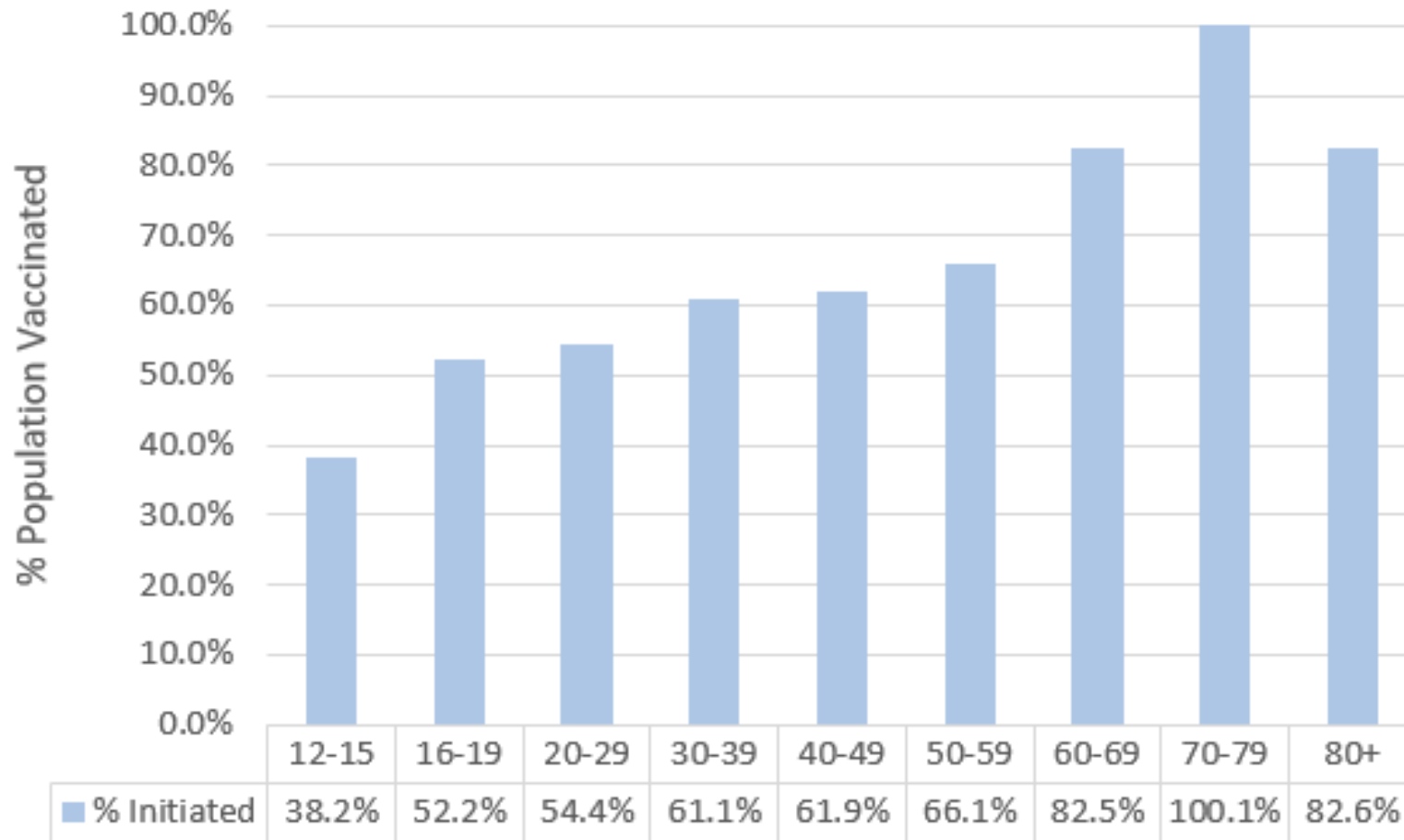

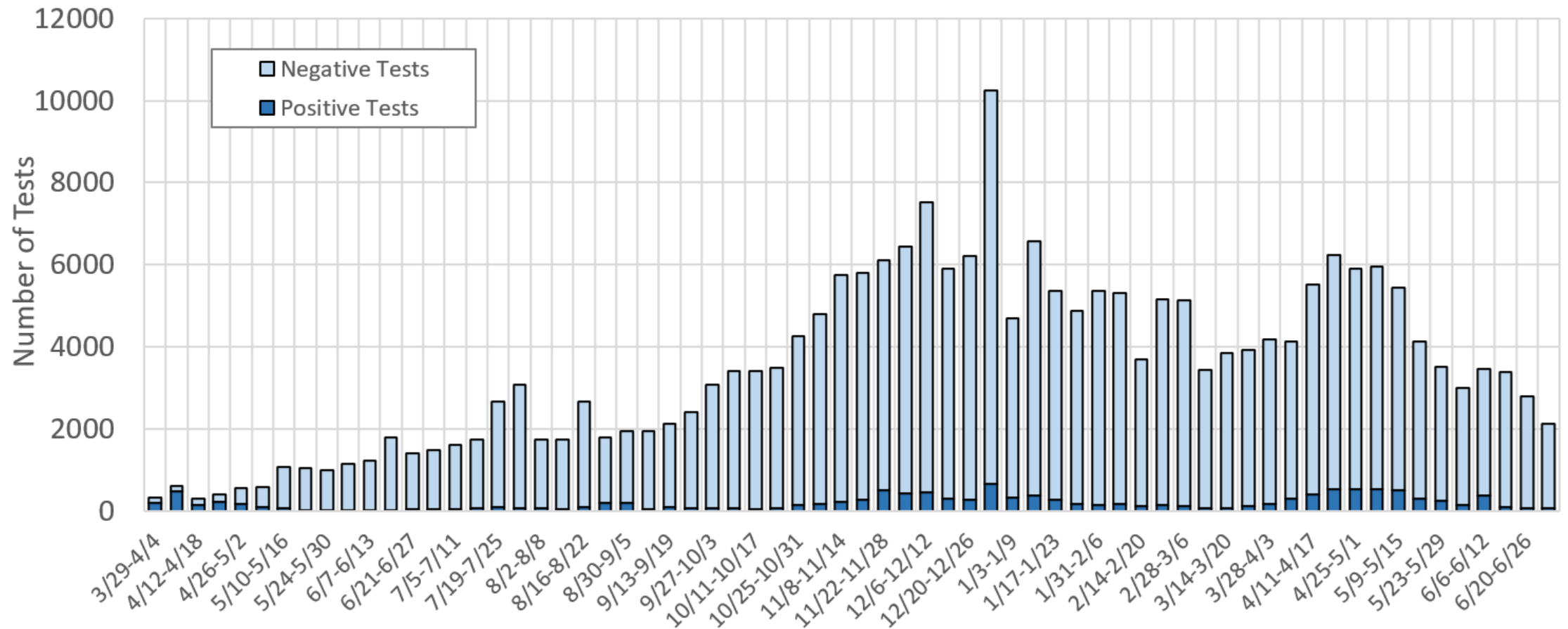
Oregonians 18 and older have now received at least one dose of a COVID-19 vaccine

COVID-19 Test Results by Week



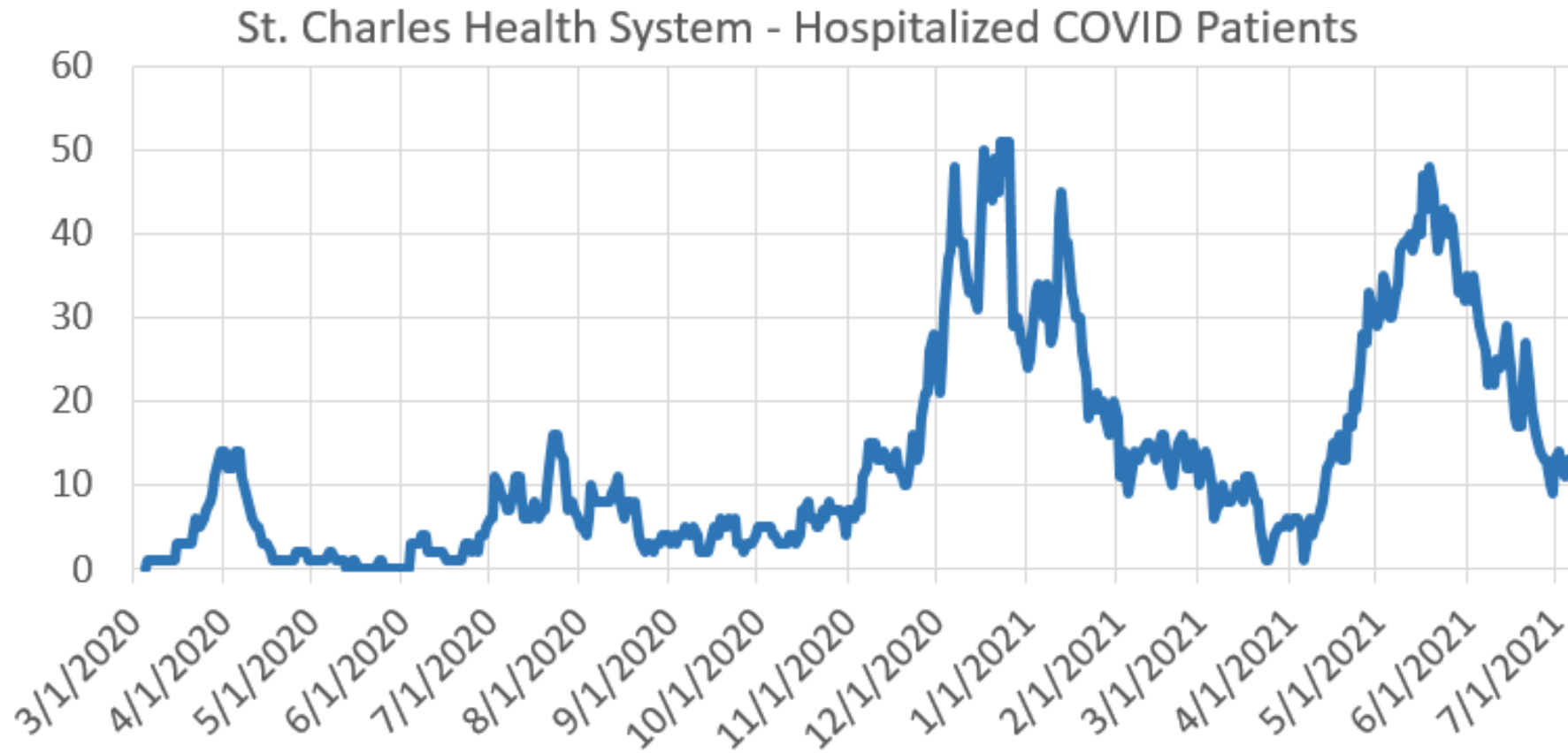
When to get tested?

- Before and after travel*
- If you have symptoms
- 6 to 9 days after you were exposed to someone who tests positive

*For some travel locations, if you had a positive test for COVID-19 within 90 days, you can use this to permit travel

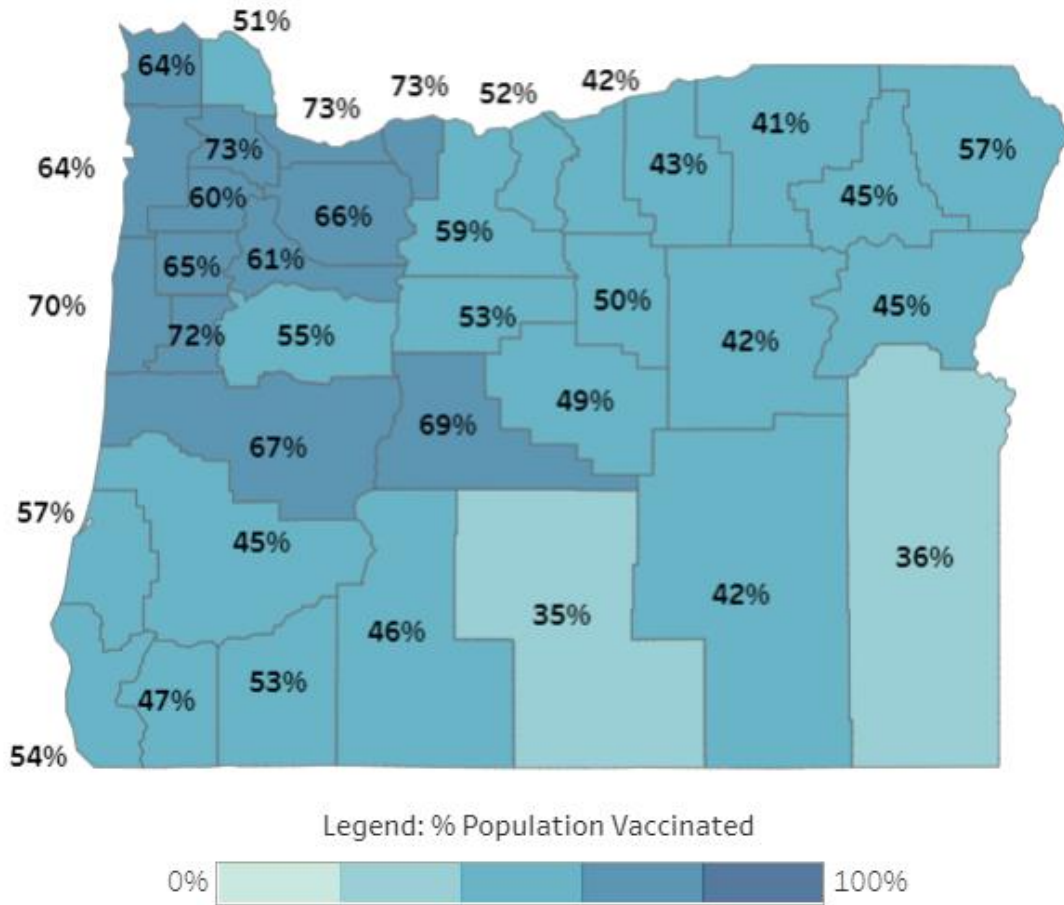


Changes to mask guidelines

- Most mask requirements lifted. Still encouraged if you're not yet vaccinated.
- Masks required at: healthcare facilities, certain workplaces required by OR-OSHA, businesses that require masks, planes, busses, trains, transportation hubs, jails and correctional facilities.
- Some people may choose to continue wearing masks due to medical conditions, personal preference, loved one who is high risk, etc.



COVID-19 Vaccinations in Deschutes County



Eligible pop. with series in progress	4.8%
Eligible pop. fully vaccinated	64.7%
Eligible pop. vaccinated*	69.4%
People vaccinated per 10,000 total population*	5,819
