


COVID-19 Case Counts by Week

COVID-19 Weekly Case Rates by Age Group








COVID-19 Test Results by Week



COVID-19 Daily Hospitalizations St. Charles Health System
















Booster Dose Planning

- Evidence-based decision making
 - Online survey on booster doses, provided in English and Spanish
 - Over 17,000 community members completed the survey!
 - Asked about intent to get boosters, locations they'd be willing to go to receive a booster, preference for walk in vs. scheduled appointments, questions/comments, and more







Booster Dose Planning

- Key Insights
 - Community members eager to receive boosters once eligible
 - Open to a variety of locations to get their shots (doesn't need to be the same location where they received their last dose)
 - Questions/comments submitted give us a sense of top concerns; able to prep COVID hotline staff accordingly
 - Continuing to use data to inform strategic planning


