Transportation Safety Action Plan

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-011

WHEREAS, the Deschutes County Road Department has completed an updated Transportation Safety Action Plan (TSAP), attached as Exhibit "A", for unincorporated Deschutes County that was funded by the United States Department of Transportation Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) program; and

WHEREAS, between 2018 and 2022, out of 2,175 reported vehicle crashes on County roads in unincorporated Deschutes County, 150 crashes resulted in serious injuries and 22 crashes resulted in fatalities; and

WHEREAS, between 2018 and 2022, 24 human lives were lost in crashes on County roads in unincorporated Deschutes County; and

WHEREAS, Deschutes County has set a goal to eliminate all fatal and serious injury crashes on the County road system, with a targeted goal of reducing fatal and serious injury crashes on the County road system by 50 percent by the year 2050; and

WHEREAS, the Deschutes County TSAP includes a list of interdisciplinary actions for implementation by County and community partners to reduce and eliminate fatal and serious injury crashes on the County road system, which include site-specific County road safety improvement projects, systemic County road crash reduction measures, and coordinated regional enforcement and education strategies; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF DESCHUTES COUNTY, OREGON, as follows:

Section 1. The Board of County Commissioners adopts the Deschutes County Transportation Safety Action Plan as provided in Exhibit "A".

Section 2. This resolution is and shall be effective from the day of passage.




