Deschutes County Weed List

Review of Deschutes County Noxious Weed List, some revisions were made, which include adding hoary allysum to the A list, broadening yellow floating heart to the entire genera of Nymphoides, and correcting the species name for spotted knapweed. The Weed Board agreed that it is ready to be presented to the Board of County Commissioners for adoption. Spring will attend Board meeting as a representative of the Weed Board for recommendation and any comments or questions BOCC may have. M/S/C

Ed Keith gave a report on his projects over the last few months. Discussion on Cost Share program, number of participants, and is funded through Secure Rural Schools (SRS) Title II funding. He is working with ODA for continued agreement to fund Orange Hawkweed program. Continue to offer sprayer through Ed. Last year approximately 40 – 45 people took advantage of this weed program that allows a homeowner to pick up sprayer with correct chemical concentrate to treat Orange Hawkweed.

Earth Day – April 25th - Jason asked if the Table Top Display would be available for Earth Day event. Reserve this through Ed Keith.
